

Clip- In Application Instructions

For best results, Hair should be clean and dry.

You will also need

- A comb
- Clips or bands to hold your hair up and out of the way while you are working
- Hairspray (optional) assist in back combing.
- A friend (optional) to help if you have trouble with the back sections.

1 Starting from the nape (bottom back of head), leave out a section of hair about 3-4cm from your hairline.

2 Back comb this section close to the scalp (instructions at bottom of page). This is done to provide added hold for the clips. Spray lightly with hairspray beforehand if need be especially when working with slippery hair textures (fine & smooth)

3 Open the clips and insert into back combed section you have made. The clip will be secure when you hear it snap.

4 When the hair is in place, style this section as desired

Follow steps 2-4 for the other pieces. Make sure each section you are taking is clean as well as in the same position on either side of your head.

5 Work your way upward toward the top of your head. Leave a 2-4cm section out from partings and hairline so added hair remains invisible.

6 Finish styling and you're ready to go. (hair can also be cut if desired)

To remove

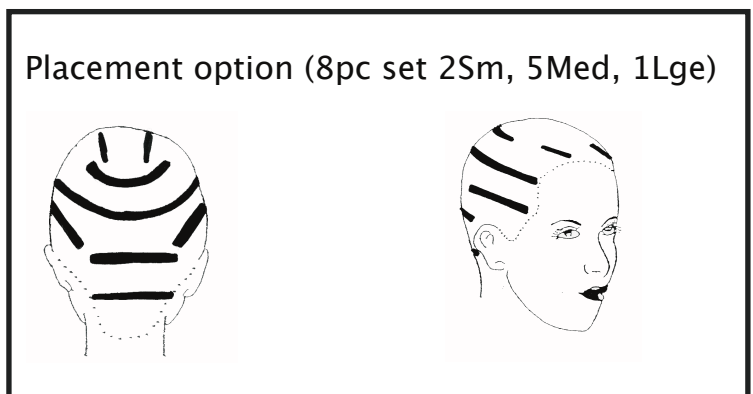
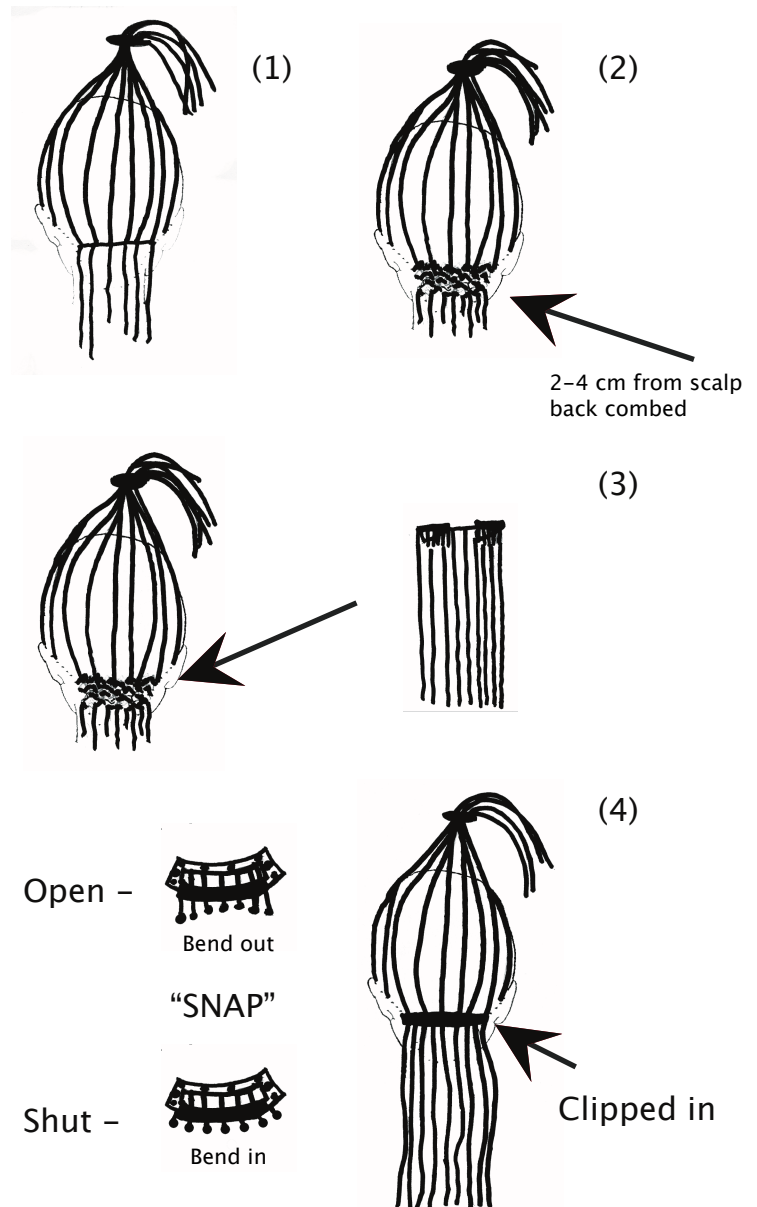
Snap clips back to open state while still in. Open all clips on the piece before you remove the extension hair.

Gently Comb out the back combed section with a comb starting from ends up to roots.

To back comb

Take the section of hair you are working with in one hand, holding at the tip. Have your comb in the other hand. Whilst still holding the section, take your comb and insert it into the section of hair you are holding 5- 10 cm from the scalp. Run the comb back along this section and as close to the scalp as you can, this will cause the hair to start matting close to the scalp. You may need to run the comb back several times to get this matting occurring. continue combing in this manner until you have a back combed section of about 2-4cm from the scalp.
